2. Question Setting and Assessment Methods of Spring 2020 Final Examination.

- a. Both online written examination and online viva will be conducted. Physical examination at MIST for military student officers and interested civil student shall also be continued.

- Uploading time of answer script will be 15 minutes instead of 20 minutes.
- f. Examination Invigilators reserve the right to deduct 5 to 10 marks from any student attempting unfair means.
- g. No examinations (CT/MT/Quiz/Viva) shall be conducted during preparatory leave.
- h. Questions shall be issued 5 minutes prior to the examination starts.
